(Genesis 1: 1-5)




Jour 2 / Day 2

(Genesis 1: 6-8)





Jour 3 / Day 3

(Genesis I: 9-13)







Jour 5 / Day 5

(Genesis 1: 20-23)






Jour 6 / Day 6

God created people in His image. He created a man and a woman.




